Reasons for Identifying livestock

 Livestock are marked using assorted marks, in a number of different ways for various reasons which include:

- To prove ownership.
- For record keeping purpose.











Methods of identification

- 1.Ear notches (Not done during student practicals)
- 2. Tattooing
- 3.Ear tags











Ear Notching

- Proved to be the best means of first marking new born animals.
- A commercial ear-clipper is used.

Rural Development

 A standard system (figure 1) in a numerical order

Students are taught how to read the notches





Tattooing

- •Tattoos are made using spiked letters placed in a pliers like instrument.
- •The area where the tattoo is to be applied in the ear (figure 2).
- Tattoo paste

Ear Tags

- They are easy to apply.
- They get lost, become illegible and soiled.













Branding

- •Calves must be brand marked at the age of six seven months.
- •Cattle are branded on the lower part of the left thigh, second owner on the left foreleg, third owner on the right thigh and the fourth owner on the right lower foreleg







Branding

- •Branding iron made by mild steel or stainless steel.
- •The height of the letters = 40-100mm and space between letters is 12.5 mm.
- Are welded on to steel rods

Why Dehorning?

- •The occurrence of severe bruises is much lower in dehorned than in horned cattle.
- Cattle can be fed more conveniently and easily with less interference from dominant animals.
- A large number of dehorned animals can be trucked, house and fed together.

There is less danger of injury to udders, flanks and



eyes as well as attendants
